2. Helped educate workers
3. Kept workers in town +source of income

1. Built over 130 factory owned houses
2. Built library with trustees tied to factory
3. General Store-only one in town of Ivoryton
4. Baseball club
5. Wheel social club
6. Funded churches

Effect of buildings  
from workers'  
perspective

1. Allowed factory to take away their homes
2. Only provided books the factory wanted them to read
3. The store had a monopoly and was overpriced
4. Factory hired "ringers" for the team.
5. Factory owners intruding in their social lives
6. Factory was the only source of funding in town and could control what faiths could be practiced
